

OCAS Data Warehouse

Reporting and Analytics Terms

Data in the new data warehouse is counted for people at 4 distinct stages of the enrolment cycle.

Application - When we refer to application data, we are talking about counting people who are seeking admission to a college program. OCAS only provides application data for paid applications. This data is processed daily into the data warehouse.

Confirmation – When we refer to confirmation data, we are talking about counting people who have accepted an offer of admission from a college. This data is received from the OCAS applicant and is processed daily into the data warehouse

Registration – This data is sent from the college two times per year – fall term (November) and winter term (March) and represents the college's count of people who are beginning their studies during that term. This data is based on the college applications processed through OCAS as part of applicant to college application process.

Enrolment - This data is sent from the college four times per year – September 10 day, November 1st, March 1st and June 30. It represents the college's count of the year one enrolment in their full-time programs during that term. It includes non-ministry funded enrolments as well as the ministry-funded.
